FINANCIAL AID DATA FORM

If you are interested in enrolling at Bossier Parish Community College during the summer 2010 session(s) and wish to apply for financial aid, you **must**:

- Complete this Summer Data Form and submit it to the Financial Aid Office. (Students who are attending BPCC for "Summer only" are NOT eligible for financial aid at BPCC.)
- Complete the 2010-2011 FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov if you intend to enroll for the fall 2010 semester (On the FAFSA website choose the 2010-2011 FAFSA and use your 2009 federal tax return to complete the application.)

NOTE: For Financial Aid purposes, summer enrollment status is defined as follows:

FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT = 12 credit hours HALF-TIME ENROLLMENT = 6 credit hours.
