## FINANCIAL AID DATA FORM

### FINANCIAL AID REFUNDS WILL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL AFTER THE LAST SCHEDULE CHANGE DATE AS PUBLISHED ON THE BPCC WEBSITE.

If you are interested in enrolling at Bossier Parish Community College during the summer 2011 session(s) and wish to apply for financial aid, you must:

- Complete this Summer Data Form and submit it to the Financial Aid Office. (Students who are attending BPCC for "Summer only" are NOT eligible for financial aid at BPCC.)
- Complete the 2011-2012 FAFSA at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) if you intend to enroll for the fall 2011 semester (On the FAFSA website choose the 2011-2012 FAFSA and use your 2010 federal tax return to complete the application.)

**NOTE: For Financial Aid purposes, summer enrollment status is defined as follows:**

**FULL-TIME ENROLLMENT = 12 credit hours HALF-TIME ENROLLMENT = 6 credit hours.**
