Criteria:

- Student must meet the admission requirements of the College.
- Student **MUST BE** enrolled in at least 12 credit hours.
- Student must be a U.S. citizen.
- Student must have earned fewer than 30 college hours.
- Student must have an ACT composite of 18 or higher.
- Entering freshmen must have a high school GPA of at least 3.00.
- College students must have an overall college GPA of at least 3.00.

BPCC ACADEMIC MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP

Bossier Parish Community College awards academic minority scholarships to *Louisiana* residents who meet certain academic qualifications. This scholarship is a tuition award only.

Criteria:

- Student must meet the admission requirements of the College.
- Student **MUST BE** enrolled in at least 12 credit hours.
- Student must be a U.S. citizen.
- Student must have earned fewer than 30 college hours.
- Student must have an ACT composite of 18 or higher.
- Entering freshmen must have a high school GPA of at least 3.00.
- College students must have an overall college GPA of at least 3.00.
- Student must be an ethnic minority (African-American, Hispanic, etc.)

****Please note that all hours earned (including hours from any other college attended) will be used to compute your cumulative hours and GPA. ****

****High school GPA will be used for entering freshmen. ****
