Certified Manufacturing Specialist™ Program

Designed by industry-training professionals, this 166-hour program provides the practical, up-to-date skills a manufacturing team needs -- from precision measurement and critical thinking to computer technology and plant safety, along with interpersonal skills such as decision-making and managing change.

The Certified Manufacturing Specialist™ curriculum produces skilled employees for manufacturing industries. Skills taught have been derived from typical business requirements for existing manufacturing employees and those entering the workforce.

The curriculum is comprised of five courses:

- Manufacturing Organizational Principles-stresses manufacturing processes and a solid foundation in business principles.
- Manufacturing Workforce Skills-focuses on personal, interpersonal, and team effectiveness.
- Manufacturing Production Requirements-teaches skills in quality control, continuous improvement and problem solving.
- Automated Manufacturing Skills-provides learners with an introduction to computerized process control and the requirements associated with automated machines.
