Rapid Response (Top Secret)

Leading Louisiana IT professionals recently matched their cyber wits and skills in the first ever *Cyber Range Competition and Workshop*, a unique cyber experience including an educational session led by global cyber experts and a cyber security competition set within one of the world's most advanced Cyber Range environments.

Hosted by BPCCC and cyber education leader Cybint, a BARBRI company, the June 1 event featured five of the area's leading IT businesses, including some such as CenturyLink, Technologix Group, and Enterprise Computing Services (ECS). Company representatives participated in one of two 90-minute competitions where they faced cyber threats and situations based on real-life scenarios and were challenged to mitigate and resolve them as quickly as possible.

The winning teams each received five scholarships from Cybint for its Cyber Security Analyst Simu-Lab Suite to be awarded to BPCCC students in the winners' company names.

The two winning teams included John Sonnier, Jason Klosterman, and Cynthia Eaton from ECS and Dustin Patterson, AJ Withem, Patrick Holladay, and Paul Williams.
