AIM/DUAL ENROLLMENT

Ninety-eight (98) High School AIM students from the Bossier School System were registered on July 30 and Aug 1.

For the first time, High School Dual Enrollment registration will be integrated with general registration to accommodate the increasing number of DE students.

High School Counselors and on high school campus DE instructors will receive a Dual Enrollment Handbook for the first time.

BPCC has successfully submitted course sections to the Supplemental Course Academy (SCA) Portal for the new school year.

Innovative Learning, Financial Aid, and Finance are working together to update the Dual Enrollment MOUs for the upcoming school year.

Two (2) DE students graduated this summer with a Certificate in General Studies.

At the close of the 2018-2019 school year, Innovative Learning attended seven (7) high school awards assemblies and graduations to recognize AIM/DE students.
