AIM/DUAL ENROLLMENT

On November 4th, Alex Ekstrom, Program Director for High School Initiatives, Lynne McCoy, Director of Academic Outreach, and Jayda Spillers, Principal for Bossier Parish School of Technology and Innovative Learning (BPSTIL) presented "Best Practices in Career and Technical Education and Dual Enrollment Partnerships" to the Board of Regents, Dual Enrollment Task Force.

On November 19th, Innovative Learning spoke to approximately 100 students at the BPSTIL Career Fair. Approximately 65% of those contacts are students currently participating in BPCC's Dual Enrollment Program through BPSTIL or on BPCC's campus. Approximately 11% of the BPSTIL Fair attendees were new contacts who demonstrated an engaged interest in attending BPCC by filling out "Prospective Student Information Cards."

BPCC is partnering with Caddo Parish Schools to establish an Extension Academy through the Louisiana Department of Education.
